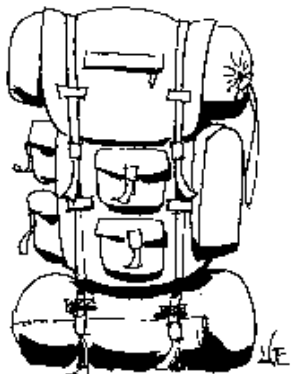

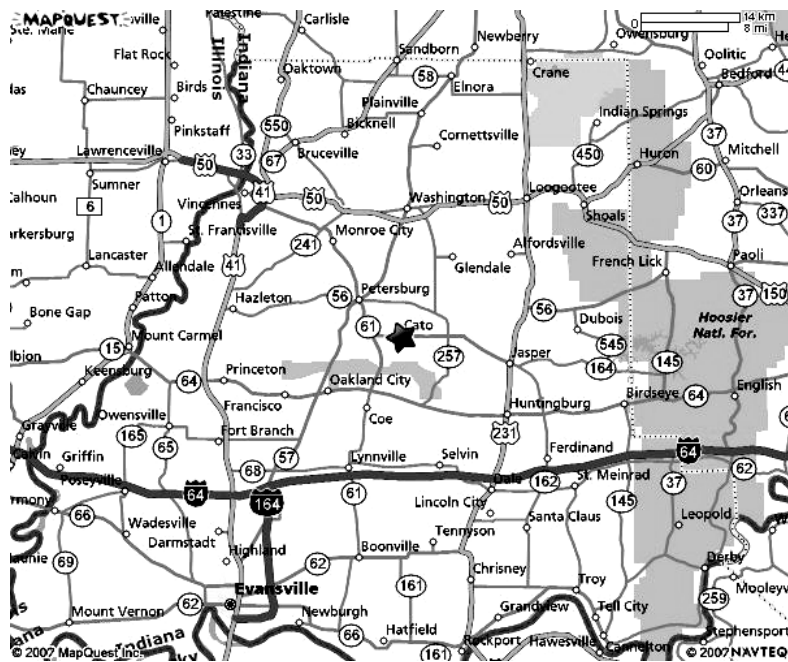

Below are two types of directions. The first one is general and takes you through Oakland City and the second one is more detailed taking you to Petersburg.

From Evansville:

Take Hwy 57N to SR 64E, go through Oakland City to SR 61N. Turn left on 61N at light. Go through Arthur, Winslow, and Campbelltown. At the light by Pike Central High School, turn right onto SR 56E. Go 3.8 miles and turn left at the Midwest Gas Transmission Compression Station sign onto 550E, go 1 mile to CR 175N. Turn right onto CR 175N and proceed into camp.

From Lynch Road and I-164:

Go north on I-164 to Hwy 57N. Continue north until you reach Petersburg, Indiana (36.8 miles). As you approach Petersburg, you will see a Jay C Supermarket on your left. You will be turning right after passing the supermarket, so slow down. Turn right on Illinois St and proceed for 1 mile. This will take you to Hwys 56 & 61. There will be a stop light at this intersection. Turn right and go 4.1 miles. This will take you to a 3-way stop intersection where Hwy 56 & 61 separate. There is a stop sign at this intersection; turn left. Pike Central High School will be on your right. Take Hwys 56 for 3.9 miles. This will be just past Cato, Indiana. There is a small sign on the right side of the road by a utility pole with an arrow pointing left. The sign says OBSR. This is the road you will need to turn onto to go to Old Ben. Turn left and go .9 miles; the entrance to Old Ben will be on the right. Take this road past two sets of gates and to the building you will see straight ahead of you.
