## Rules for Merit Badge University

- Current Merit Badge Pamphlet revision dates:

- **Cost is \$2 per person. (Scouts/Adults) If you are attending Training, Please pay separately. See Pages 7-9 for more info.**
- Check-in will be at the administration building; *Scoutmaster and Senior Patrol Leader only. Other boys and leaders will remain outside until after Flag Raising.*
- Scouts and Scouters will adhere to the Scout Oath and Law throughout the day, and are asked to wear their uniforms.
- Webelos are not permitted to participate in any merit badge seminar. Merit badge work is only for registered Boy Scouts.
- Scouts will leave computers and other technology alone.
- Once Scouts arrive, they may not leave the campus (except for MB field trips) until they have been released at the end of the day. They will stay in their designated area, no wandering around the buildings, parking lots or campus.
- Each participating unit **MUST** have at least 2 adults in attendance during the entire MBU. Adult leader training is taking place during the MBU, you can be in training and still qualify as an adult leader in attendance.
- Each Scout is also responsible for his own paper, pencils, merit badge pamphlets, and any expenses that need to be paid that day as well as a merit badge "blue card" signed by the Scoutmaster. Blue cards are not available that day. Not all requirements for each merit badge will be covered that day. Some requirements must be completed either before or after attending the session. Each Scout should read the merit badge pamphlet and be familiar with the requirements. Having all of the prerequisite requirements completed before that day is a must, to complete the MB the day of the University.
- Room assignments will be on display in the lobby of the building upon arrival and check-in.

### Lunch

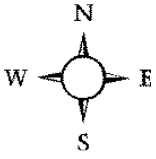
**No food or drinks will be provided.** Scouts need to bring a sack lunch. Troops are responsible for keeping lunches cold and for trash removal. Once Scouts arrive, they may not leave the campus. Leaders may leave to pick up lunch in town, but at least one leader will remain on campus to insure the safety of their boys, in case of an accident or injury. No eating or drinking in classrooms. Troops will sit together during lunch and adult leaders will be responsible for their Scouts during the entire day. If weather permits, scouts may want to bring a lawn chair for use during the lunch period. If the weather is bad, Scouts can stay in and use the hallway for eating and drinking, during the lunch period.

### Cleanup

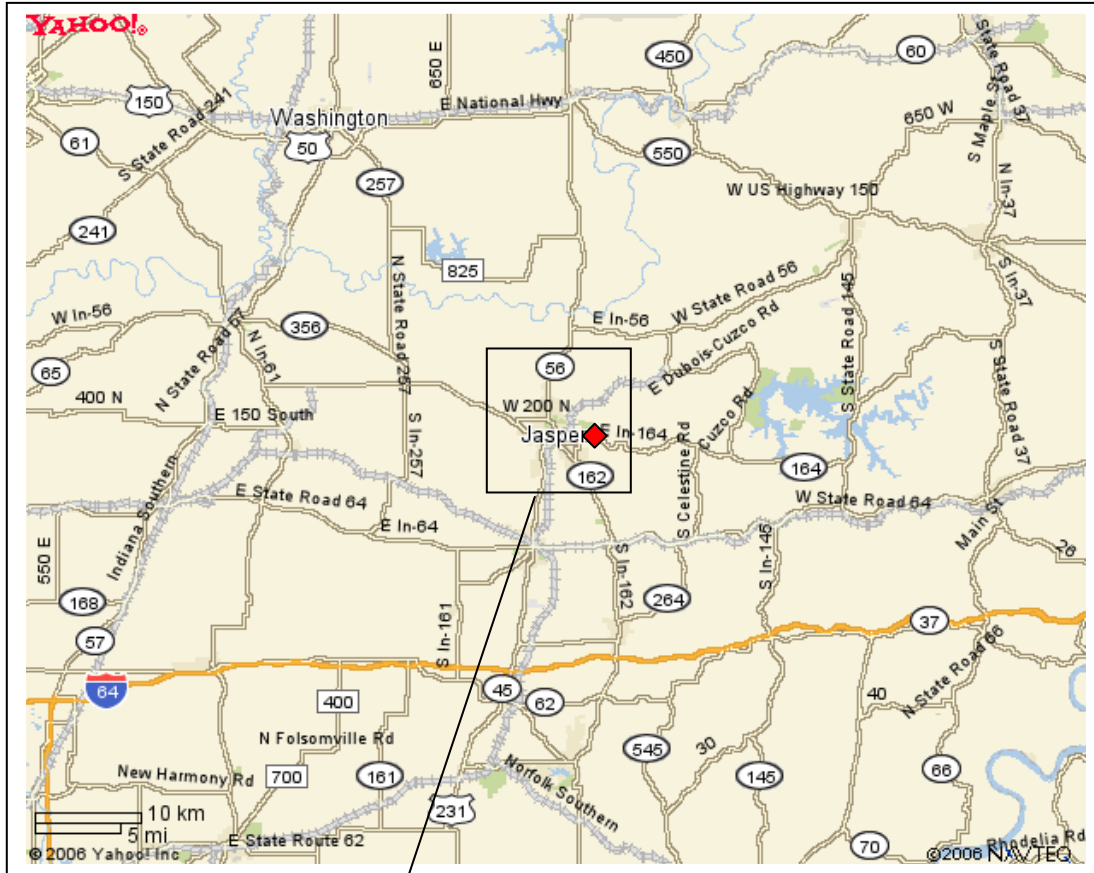
