Cub Scout Field Day is a half-day event full of non-competitive activities for Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts, and Webelos. Field Day will occur in the sunshine, rain, or snow.

Packs have their choice of two sessions at Eykamp Scout Center on **Saturday, October 16:**



Morning Session: 7 am – 11:45 am

Opening Ceremony	7:15 am – 7:30 am
Closing Ceremony	11:30 am – 11:45 am

NOTE: Parents picking up their Cub Scouts from the first session will need to pick them up promptly at 11:45 to make room for the afternoon participants.

Afternoon Session: 12:30 pm – 5:15 pm

Registration	12:15 pm – 12:40 pm
Opening Ceremony	12:45 pm – 1 pm
Closing Ceremony	5 pm – 5:15 pm

The Eykamp Scout Center is located at 3501 E. Lloyd Expressway. A map is included with this form (make copies for your parents). All Scouts should gather at the Williams Amphitheater behind the main building. The registration table will be located just behind the Scout Center. Please send only one representative from your Pack to the registration table.

Early Bird Registration - \$5 per Scout - Early Bird Deadline: Thursday, September 30

Registration Received After Sept. 30 - \$7 per Scout - Registration Deadline: Wednesday, October 6

All Scouts must be registered by October 6 . . . NO EXCEPTIONS!

Remember: **Cub Scouts with FREE passes MUST pre-register & free passes must be turned in with the registration forms.**

The fee covers program materials and an event patch for each registered Scout. Any adult who would like to purchase a patch may do so for \$1.00 (if there are enough available). Unit registration forms **WITH FEES** are to be submitted to the Eykamp Scout Center by **UNIT LEADERS ONLY**. **Due to the large number of Cub Scouts attending, we encourage all units to sign up as soon as possible as the sessions fill up quickly. Each session will be limited to 500 boys.** Please provide one leader for every six boys attending.

To avoid dangerous backups on the Lloyd Expressway and to enhance safety for our Scouts, parents and leaders should be instructed to enter the grounds from Lincoln Avenue and park in the lot located near the southeast corner of the Scout Center complex. **Please do not park in the soccer field or baseball field parking lots.** Scouts should wear a Scout t-shirt or plain T-shirt and bring their own water bottle with them. Lunches will NOT be provided. **A trading post will be set up with food and drink to purchase if you choose to do so.**

Bring your Pack flag for Opening Ceremonies. Flags are to remain in place during Field Day events until Closing Ceremony. There will be flag holders in place for Pack flags at the Williams Amphitheater. **CANNED FOOD DRIVE NEW THIS YEAR!** Every Scout should bring at least one can of food with him and we will have a food collection for Tri-State Food Bank. Food will be distributed throughout the district.

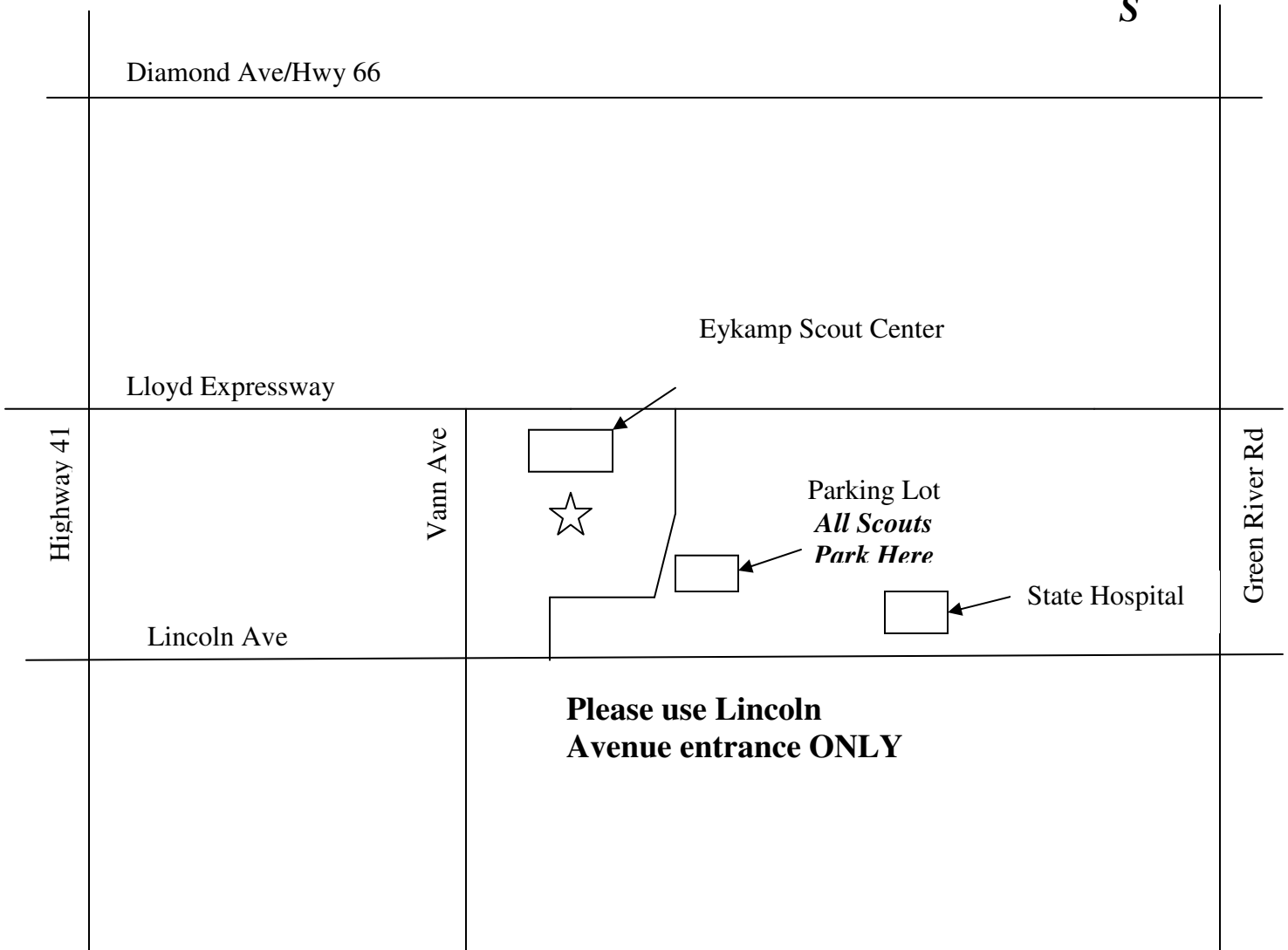
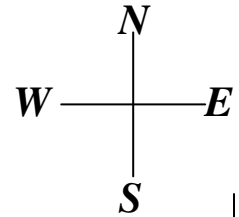
