A choice of one of the following trees:

- Swamp White Oak
- October Glory Maple
- Sugar Time Crabapple
- Aristocrat Pear

One bag (2 cubic feet) of hardwood mulch

One 40 pound bag of compost

Woodace fertilize pellets (2)

One 100th Anniversary tree marker and post
