

Uniform Assistance Application

Program Information

One of Scouting's methods of youth development is the uniform. Wearing the uniform is an action that shows each Scout's commitment to the aims and purposes of Scouting. The uniform also provides a way for Scouts to display the awards they have earned by completing requirements found in their Scout handbook.

Recognizing the essential role of the uniform and handbook in Scouting, the Buffalo Trace Council offers this program for Scouts who would not otherwise be able to purchase a uniform or handbook. Funding for this program is made possible by the annual Friends of Scouting campaign, Council Popcorn Sale and local United Way funding in some areas.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this program, a Scout:

1. Must be a registered Scout.
2. Has earned the Bobcat badge or Scout badge of rank.
3. Participate in popcorn sales.
4. **Must fill this form out completely.**

Application Processing

This application must be submitted to the Eykamp Scout Center and will be reviewed by the district professional.

Once the application has been approved, the parent will receive a call from Scout Shop personnel detailing uniform specifics and discussion of pick up method.

Note – we cannot guarantee that every Scout that applies for this program will receive assistance. Funds available are limited each year.
