# RENEWAL PROCESS

Two processes that are completely separate and serve different purposes.

## UNIT RENEWAL

The annual national process renews the unit's affiliation with Scouting America. Unit renewal does not involve the renewal of youth and adult leader memberships.

A unit can renew starting January 1, 2026 (two months prior to their expiration date. There is a two-month lapse period. Units expiring in February 2026 drop in April 2026.

The unit leader (Scoutmaster/ Cubmaster/ Advisor), Committee Chair, and Charter Organization Representative have access to the tools on [my.scouting.org](https://my.scouting.org)



## MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

Membership renewal process syncs with each member's annual enrollment date. Members (youth & adult) join Scouting year-round, and their membership fees are tied to the month of their enrollment.

A member is able to renew their membership starting two months prior to their expiration date. There is a two-month lapse period. Email notice is sent to the email associated with the member's account.

Renewals are encouraged to be completed prior to the expiration so there is no lapse in insurance coverage and access to Scoutbook+ is not interrupted.


Did you know that you can support Buffalo Trace Council by purchasing an Eagle Scout license plate in Indiana/Illinois?
